Science—We just started our unit on Weather.

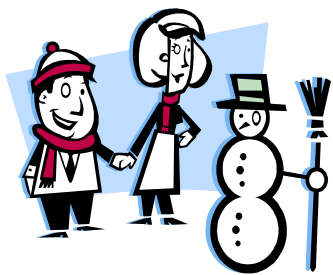
Religion—We will continue to learn about the parts of Mass. We will also go
