The Kindergarten curriculum for March is listed below.

READING/PHONICS:

Week 1: Letter G. Sightwords: on-from-find-this-but-came

Week 2: 3rd Quarter Tests over all letters and sounds studied.

Week 3: Letter Rr. Sightwords: be, will, into, that, who, your.

Week 4: Letter "Dd". Sightwords: go-here-soon-for-they-up.

Weeks 5: Finish Letter Dd.

MATH:

Counting nickels to 50 cents, ABC patterns, printing #1-20, Naming Days of the Week, ABBC patterns, identifying left/right, sorting Tangrams by size (small, med., large), and measuring.

HANDWRITING:

Print various upper and lowercase letters matching the letter of the week.

RELIGION:

*We will study about the Season of Lent and try to grow closer to God during this special season.

*We will follow Jesus on his journey through the Stations of the Cross. We will color a picture of each station and turn it into our own "Stations of the Cross Booklet."

*Read Easter books explaining the story of Jesus' death on the cross.

*Deed of the Day: Each day during Lent, we will pick a good deed/chore/or something to give up for that particular day. Ask your child what the Deed of the Day is.

*Saint of the Month:

We will read about Saint Patrick and color a picture of him to Put in our "Book of Saints."
