Cost is 50¢ each.

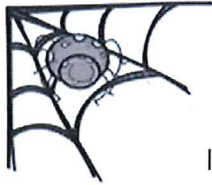

May we all pray together for Ms. Smith as she continues her treatment and healing journey. We pray that the Lord will hold her close during this time. Amen."



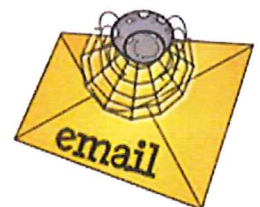
Parent / Teacher Conferences

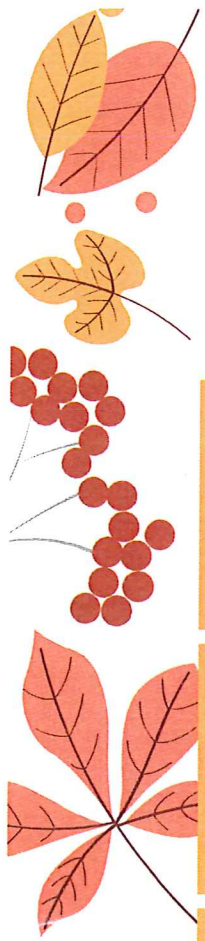
