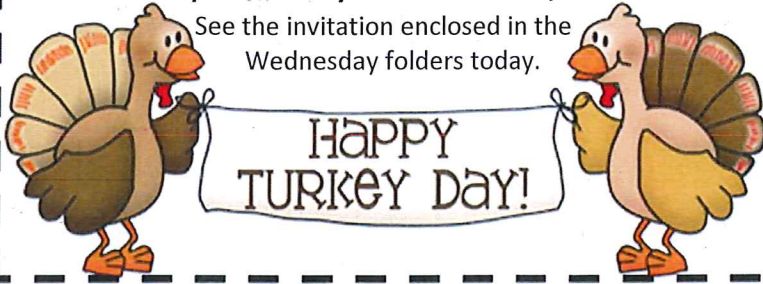


Home & School Meeting

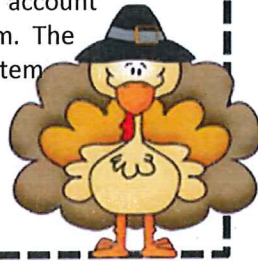
Prevent and Protect

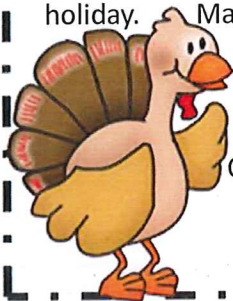

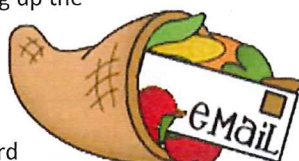


DARE Graduation

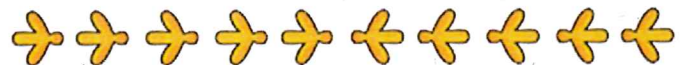


Dartball Tournament

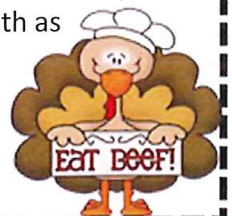


Prayer for Ms. Smith

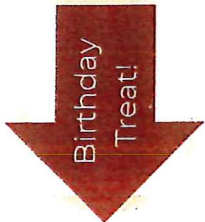

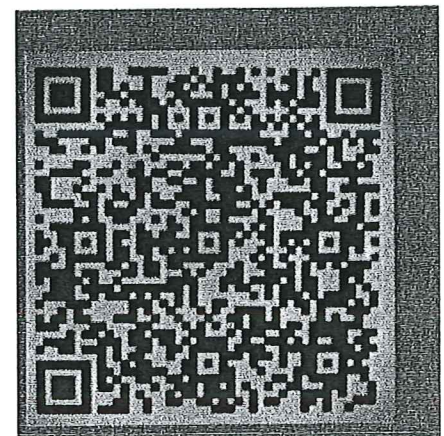

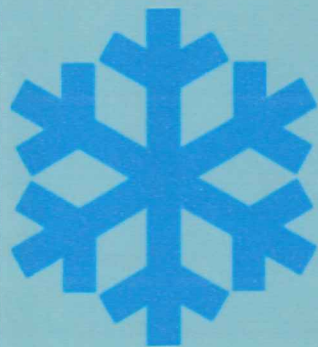
