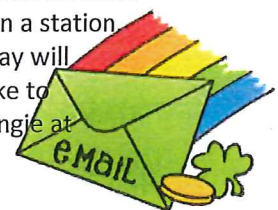
permission slip. If they do not have a signed slip, they will join the students in the Parish Center. If you want to experience the Eclipse at home with your family, you may pick up your children at noon.

Prayer for Ms. Smith

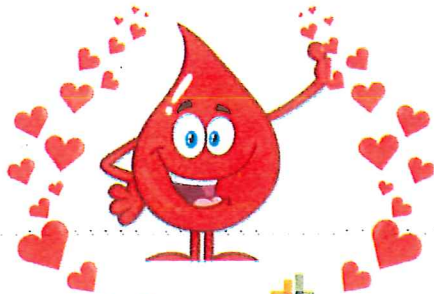

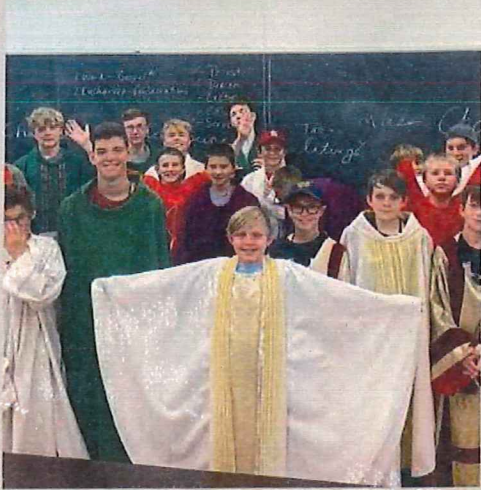
